

Biography Bottle Part 1

A "Bottle Buddy" is a representation of a person who has made significant contribution to our world. It is a "dressed-up" one-liter bottle with a Styrofoam ball to serve as the Bottle Buddy's head. When you create a "Bottle Buddy" people should be able to recognize the famous person (or at least make some good guesses) by the clothes he/she wears and the telling accessories you use to support your representation.

Materials and Bottle Buddy Construction:

1. One-liter bottle- emptied and refilled with sand or gravel to one third.
2. Styrofoam Ball- Approximately the same width dimensions (or slightly larger) as the one-liter bottle.
3. Clothes: Select materials appropriate to your character. Felt can work fine to construct a jacket or pants.
4. Representative Items: Whatever will capture the essence of what the character is known for. If known in the medical field, a stethoscope. A suit and tie for many politicians etc.
5. Facial Detail: select eyes, nose, mouth, hair, beards, and/or mustaches and other head related items from a local hobby shop to support the bottle buddy's facial features.
6. Optional items: Hats, arms, shoes, canes, glasses, should be used as needed to enhance the representation of the character.
