Subject: SBG Report Cards

Dear Fremont School District 79 Families:

*This is the seventh installment in a series of communications regarding our shift to standards-based grading across the district. [Our District website](#) has prior communications and additional resources posted.*

Report cards are set to go live on Wednesday, November 20. As we prepare for our math classes across the District to communicate student learning on the report cards with standards-based grading we wanted to take a moment to share more about this shift.

Here are some elements you will see that implemented on the math report:

- 4-6 strands have been identified for each course.
- A level of progression will be reported for each academic strand (1-4). This reporting of specific strands will replace the traditional overall letter grade.
- Not all strands will be reported on each academic term in all subject areas.
- Academic grades will be reported separately from habits of success grades.
- Report cards will be compiled and sent home once per trimester.
- Teacher comments will be included on report cards. The expectation is that the comments are specific and meaningful to each student.

In 2020-21 our English-Language Arts courses will be reporting in this same fashion. In 2021-22 all other courses will follow suit.
